

SPECIAL WEATHER STATEMENT AND EVENT UPDATES

- 1. The forecast is currently calling for less than 50% chance of rain Saturday, high of 68 degrees, and winds 20-30 knots from the East.
- 2. These forecasted conditions have heightened our concerns over participant safety. Therefore, we are altering the course to eliminate Presque Isle Bay and Horseshoe Pond from the paddle.
- 3. The NEW ROUTE will be contained within the protected Lagoons and a portion of Misery Bay. The route is no longer a complete loop.
- 4. The NEW ROUTE is attached below.
- 5. It is at each paddler's discretion to complete all, some, or none of the poker stops -and in no particular order/sequence.
- 6. You can draw your remaining cards at the Presque Isle Partnership tent.
- 7. If you choose to NOT paddle, you have the option to hike to the poker stops, or you may draw all your cards at the Presque Isle Partnership tent.
- 8. Presque Isle Poker Paddle is a rain or shine event, and all registration fees are non-refundable.
- 9. The paddle portion of the event will be cancelled if there is lightning detected nearby, and no make-up day will be scheduled.



Safety First

- A PFD is required by law to be with you, and we strongly encourage you to wear it!
- Safety whistles will be provided.
- Follow navigation guidelines.
- In the event of a critical emergency, CALL 911
- For non-life-threating emergencies, call the Event Director, 814-602-9655

Launch Permits

Not needed at Presque Isle State Park.

Tickets

• No need to print. We'll check you in with our master list.

Launch Times

• Stick to your assigned launch time to avoid congestion. Don't worry if you're a bit late.

Participant Number

• Memorize your assigned number. It's essential for the day.

Redeeming your Meal Ticket at Oasis Pub 3122 W Lake Rd, Erie, PA 16505

To ensure a quality experience at the Oasis Pub, please follow these guidelines for redeeming your picnic-style buffet Meal Ticket:

- Your launch time will dictate the timeframe in which you may redeem your YELLOW Meal Ticket.
- At check in, you will receive your meal ticket and redemption instructions.
- You must present your YELLOW Meal Ticket at Oasis Pub
 - For launch times 7:30am 9:30am, you must redeem your buffet meal ticket between 10:00am and 12:30pm.
 - For launch times 9:30am -11:00am, redeem your buffet meal ticket between 12:30pm and 3:00pm.
- Please understand that these times are set to reduce congestion and avoid overwhelming the staff at Oasis Pub.
- Be sure to check in with our volunteers at Oasis when you arrive.
- Buffet service ends at 3:00pm.

Arrival and Check-in

- ALL PADDLERS MUST CHECK-IN AT THE PARTNERSHIP TENT
- Arrive at <u>Lagoon's Boat Launch</u> 30 minutes before your launch time.
- Stay left of the orange cones and pull into the grass to unload gear.
- Check in at the Presque Isle Partnership tent to receive your player card, dry-bag, whistle, map, and meal ticket.
- Bring cash or a card for a \$5 bonus donation card and the 50/50 raffle.
- Park your vehicle at Beach 11 and take the shuttle back to the launch.

Kayak Rentals

- Arrive at Presque Isle Boat Rental next to the launch area.
- Kayak renters are permitted to use the Boat Rental Parking.
- Check-in at the Presque Isle Partnership over near the boat launch.
- After checking in, you can then proceed to the Boat Rental. The staff there will have your name on record, and they do require a driver's license and credit card at the time of rental. The special rate for poker paddlers is \$25. At this point, you're all set to get underway!

Restrooms

- There are portable toilets at the Lagoons Boat Launch.
- A restroom facility is accessible in Marina Lake at the <u>East Pier</u>.

Launching

- Launch on time, or as close as you can to your chosen launch time.
- The direction of travel and the order of stops is at your discretion.

Card Stops

- There are 5 stops:
- B.L. #3, B.L. #5, B.L. #7, Perry Monument, and Misery Bay (west bank).
- Again, it is at each paddler's discretion to complete all, some, or none of the poker stops -and in no particular order/sequence.
- Stay in your boat.
- At each stop, begin by calling out your number. A volunteer will draw a card, and you'll circle it on your player card with the provided permanent marker.
- We will record your card on our master sheet, also.
- Be on your way to your next stop.

Finish

• ALL PADDLERS MUST CHECK-OUT AT THE PARTNERSHIP TENT.

- This is your last chance to get your donation card to help strengthen your hand. Donation card is \$5; One per paddler.
- Record your best hand at the PARTNERSHIP TENT. A staff member will assist you.
- \$300 will go to the best hand and \$150 to the "weakest" best hand. The weakest hand is nothing, 7 high.
- If there is a tie, the winnings can be split if both parties agree or there will be a draw-off for the highest card for best hand / lowest card for the worst hand.
- Take the shuttle to Beach 11 to retrieve your vehicle, then gather your gear and head to Oasis Pub & Tiki Bar.
- Remember to bring your YELLOW Meal Ticket and to redeem it within your designated timeframe.
